145

GED® Passing Score

The GED® test has a passing score of 145 for each test subject. To earn your high school equivalency, you'll need to score 145 or higher on all four subjects.

165 - 174

GED® College Ready

Scoring above 165 (on any test subject) means you have demonstrated you are ready to take college level courses and you may qualify for waivers from placement testing or developmental education requirements if you enroll in college.

175 - 200

GED® College Ready + Credit

Scoring above 175 (on any test subject) means you have demonstrated skills that could qualify for up to 10 college credit hours.

GED Subtest	Score Required	ACE Recommendation	OSUIT Credit Granted
Reasoning Through Language Arts	175-200	1 semester hour lower division in humanities	ACE recommends 1 credit hour. If we have a variable credit HUM course, we could just automatically assign students to it (e.g., HUM 2901)
Mathematical Reasoning	175-200	3 semester hours lower division in college algebra	MATH 1513: Pre-Calculus ACE recommends college algebra (what we call pre-calculus). It is more easily transferred to any degree, so I propose we give credit for pre-calc rather than math for critical thinking.

GED Subtest	Score Required	ACE Recommendation	OSUIT Credit Granted
Science	175-200	3 semester hours lower division in introductory physical science (survey, without laboratory)	<p>PHYS 1204: General Physical Science</p> <p>ACE recommends 3 credits, but I'm fine with giving students the extra credit hour</p> <p>This is the only physical science class we offer. Doesn't include a lab. Non-science majors.</p>
Social Studies	175-200	3 semester hours lower division in economic thinking, society and social arrangements or humanities	<p>SOC 1113: Introductory Sociology</p> <p>ACE recommendations lean more toward the social/behavioral area or humanities, rather than civics. I think giving students sociology credit might be nice. It gives them credit in another category.</p>

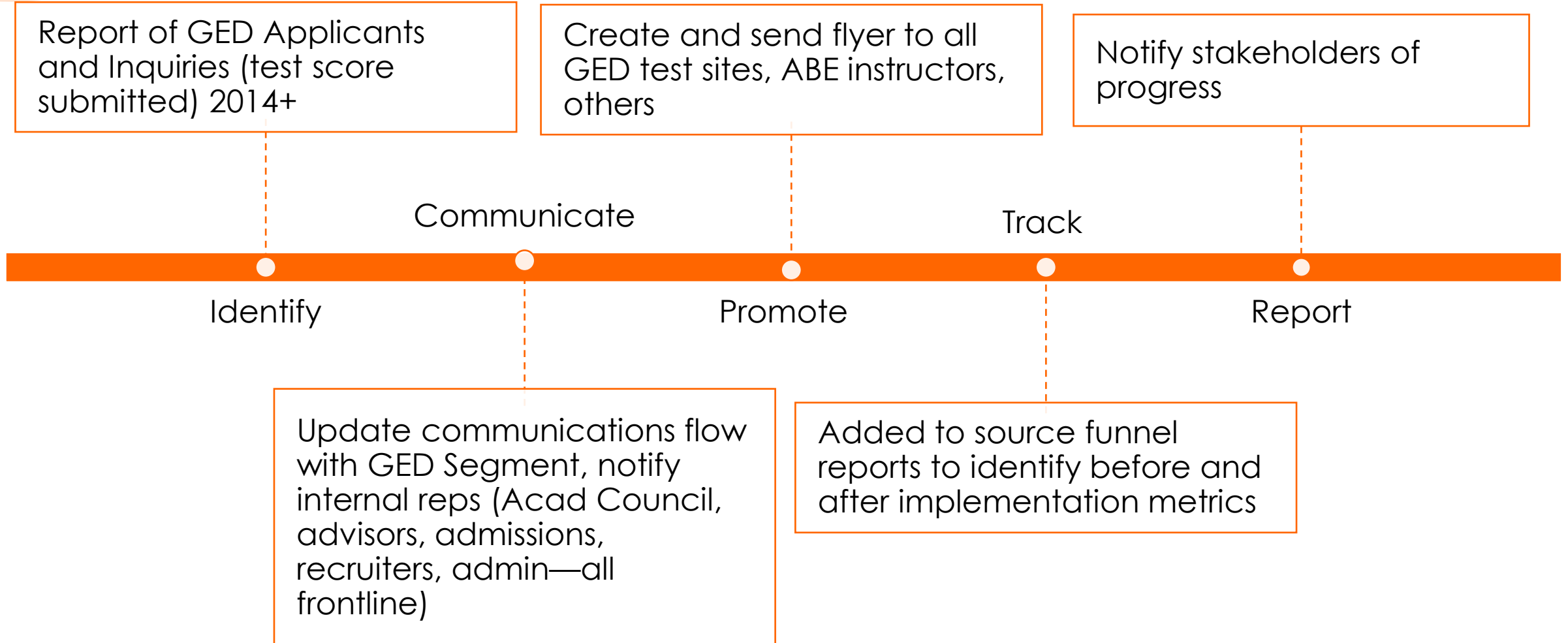
